Deciduous Shrubs

Berberis thunbergii 'Concorde'

Height: 1.5'- 2'

Width: 2.5'-3'

Bloom Color: Yellow

Hardiness: Zone 4

Here is a dwarf globe-shaped barberry with deep purple, velvety foliage and red new growth making it an attractive plant for the perennial garden or the front of a shrub border. Sparse red fruit. Can tolerate dry conditions. Full sun.

Concorde Barberry

Caragana arborescens 'Pendula'

Height: 2'- 3'

Width: 6'-18'

Bloom Color: Yellow

Hardiness: Zone 2

Usually grown as a top-grafted weeping tree, we grow this tough flowering plant as a spreading-mounding groundcover. Bright green pinnately compound leaves cascade along arching branches. Can be used in harsh, exposed areas for mass plantings. Yellow pea-like flowers are partially hidden when they bloom in May-June, followed by small pods. Adapts to most soils (even poor sites) and is quite drought tolerant. Full sun. Zone 2.

Creeping Peashrub

Hydrangea arborescens (Invincibelle™ Spirit) Invincibelle™ Spirit Hydrangea

Height: 3'- 4'

Width: 3'-4'

Bloom Color: Pink

Hardiness: Zone 3

Proven Winners®--A plant breeding breakthrough a Invincibelle™ is the first ever pink form of *Hydrangea arborescens*. It is a rebloomer producing new flowers right up to frost. One dollar from each sale is donated to the Breast Cancer Research Foundation. Part sun to shade.

Hydrangea paniculata (Quick Fire®)

Height: 6'- 8'

Width: 4'-5'

Bloom Color: White/Pink/Rose

Hardiness: Zone 3

Proven Winner® --Wow - blooms up to a month earlier than other *H. paniculata* varieties! White flowers age to dark pink before other hydrangeas even begin to bloom. Upright habit to 6' - 8'. Great for summer and fall color. Blooms on new wood. Part sun to shade.

Quick Fire® Hydrangea

Perovskia x 'Little Spire'

Height: 2'- 3'

Width: 18"-24"

Bloom Color: Lavender Blue

Hardiness: Zone 4

The cultivar 'Little Spire' is a semi-dwarf that grows to half the mature size of the species and does not sucker. Blooms extremely well in poor, dry soil. Deer resistant, but attracts butterflies and honeybees. Good for cut flowers. It has a lengthy bloom time from early summer into autumn. A great low maintenance plant for xeriscape gardens or containers. Full sun.

Little Spire Russian Sage

A John Starnes selection. Large 3" fuschia colored centiflora type rose (41 petals), strongly fragrant, hardy own root, heavy 4 week long bloom period in June followed by a lighter bloom in August/September

Ruby Voodoo Rose

Sambucus nigra 'Aureomarginata'

Hardiness: Zone 5

Rapidly growing shrub with creamy variegation on the foliage. Does best in partial shade and requires ample soil moisture. May have some die-back in severe winters.

Variegated Elderberry

Viburnum x 'Sarcoxie'

Height: 6'- 8'

Width: 6'-8'

Bloom Color: White

Hardiness: Zone 4

Extremely fragrant, semi-evergreen Viburnum that blooms earlier than *V. burkwoodii* and *V. carlesii*, and is hardier. A cross between *V. carlesii* and *V. x burkwoodii* introduced by Sarcoxie Nurseries of Sarcoxie, MO in 1972. Rare in the trade, but we will be producing this great plant in the upcoming years. Full sun to part shade.

Juniperus communis depressa (Blueberry Delight®)

Height: 12"- 18"

Width: 4'-5'

Bloom Color: NA

Hardiness: Zone 3

Blueberry Delight is a dense, low, spreading juniper with rich, dark green needles having a contrasting silvery blue line on the upper surface. Comes from North Dakota State University. Full sun.

Vitis 'Marquette'

The Marquette Grape, *Vitis 'Marquette'* (PPAF), is a red wine grape that combines cold hardiness and disease resistance with excellent wine quality. Tasters noted a deep red color and desirable aromas. The open, orderly, and somewhat upright growth habit of Marquette is considered highly desirable for efficient vineyard management, and fruit exposure to the sun conducive to maximizing wine quality. Marquette has withstood temperatures as low as -36° F without serious injury. Resistance to common grape diseases such as, downy mildew, powdery mildew, and black rot, this grape tolerates a wide range of soil conditions, but must have good drainage. Full sun. Zone 3

Vitis 'Trollhaugen'

A hardy, blue, seedless grape (with soft seed remnants) developed by Elmer Swenson, a pioneering grape breeder who introduced a number of new cultivars. Medium blue berries are born on compact, medium sized clusters. Sweet and mild Concord-like flavor. Ripens extremely early to high sugar but can hang in good condition until a hard frost. Hardy to near -30 F. Full sun. Zone 4

Celastrus scandens (Autumn Revolution™)

Height: 10'- 20'

Width: 10'-15'

Bloom Color: Insignificant

Hardiness: Zone 2

The majority of the flowers on this plant are 'perfect' meaning that the flower itself has both male and female parts. You only need one plant to bear fruit; the very ornamental orange to red berries are twice the size of that of the species! Berries retain their color well when cut and used in dried arrangements. Glossy green leaves on twining branches. Full sun.

Autumn Revolution™ Bittersweet
